- Most importantly, no formal changes have been made to the ACA. It is still the law despite the many challenges, news stories and proposed changes.
- Yes, there has been an executive order related to the ACA, which create a lot of uncertainty. However, no formal changes have been made.
- Congress continues discussing the repeal of the ACA but has yet to do so.
- Continue enrolling in [Special Enrollment Periods](#) for 2017 coverage if you are eligible. Contracts have been signed and plans are in place.
